	<h3 style="text-align: center;">Small Intestine ★</h3> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Digestive System</li> <li>• Where most digestion occurs</li> <li>• Food moves from stomach to small intestine</li> </ul>
	<h3 style="text-align: center;">Gall Bladder</h3> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Digestive system</li> <li>• Stores bile</li> <li>• Bile is used to break down fat</li> </ul>
	<h3 style="text-align: center;">Liver</h3> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Digestive system</li> <li>• Helps body digest food</li> <li>• Produces and discharges bile (greenish-yellowish digestive fluid)</li> <li>• Bile travels from liver to small intestine and aids in digestion of fats</li> </ul>
	<h3 style="text-align: center;">Stomach</h3> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Digestive system</li> <li>• Major site of mechanical and chemical digestion</li> </ul>

	<p style="text-align: center;"><b>Lungs</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Where oxygen is added to blood and carbon dioxide is removed</li> </ul>
	<p style="text-align: center;"><b>Spleen</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Blood flows from aorta to spleen</li> <li>• Damaged red blood cells are removed along with certain bacteria</li> </ul>
	<p style="text-align: center;"><b>Kidney</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Filters blood in order to remove waste and produce urine</li> <li>• Left and right kidney</li> </ul>
	<p style="text-align: center;"><b>Pancreas</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Produces digestive juices required to break down food</li> <li>• Neutralizes stomach acid</li> <li>• Produces insulin and glucagon which regulate the body's sugar balance and metabolism</li> </ul>
